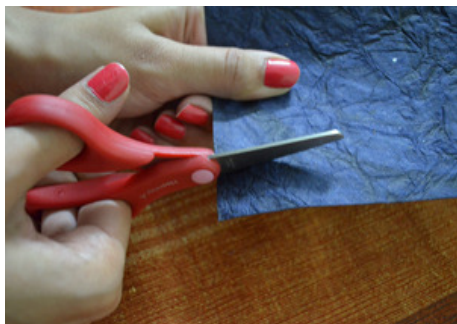


How to Find Your Ring Size?

We suggest two excellent ways to find your ring size, without going to the jeweler

OPTION A:

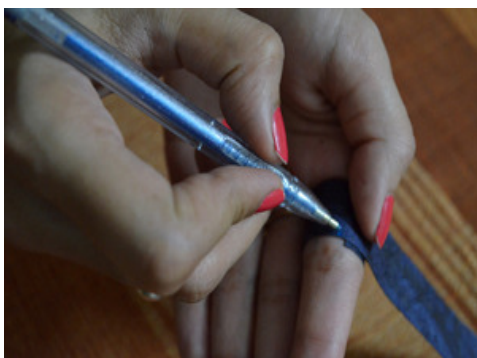
Follow the simple steps given below: *The same could be done with the help of a thread instead of a paper.*



Cut a strip of paper/thread



Snugly wrap it around the base of the finger that you wish to measure.



Using a pen mark the line at the point where the strip of paper/thread meets, forming a circle.

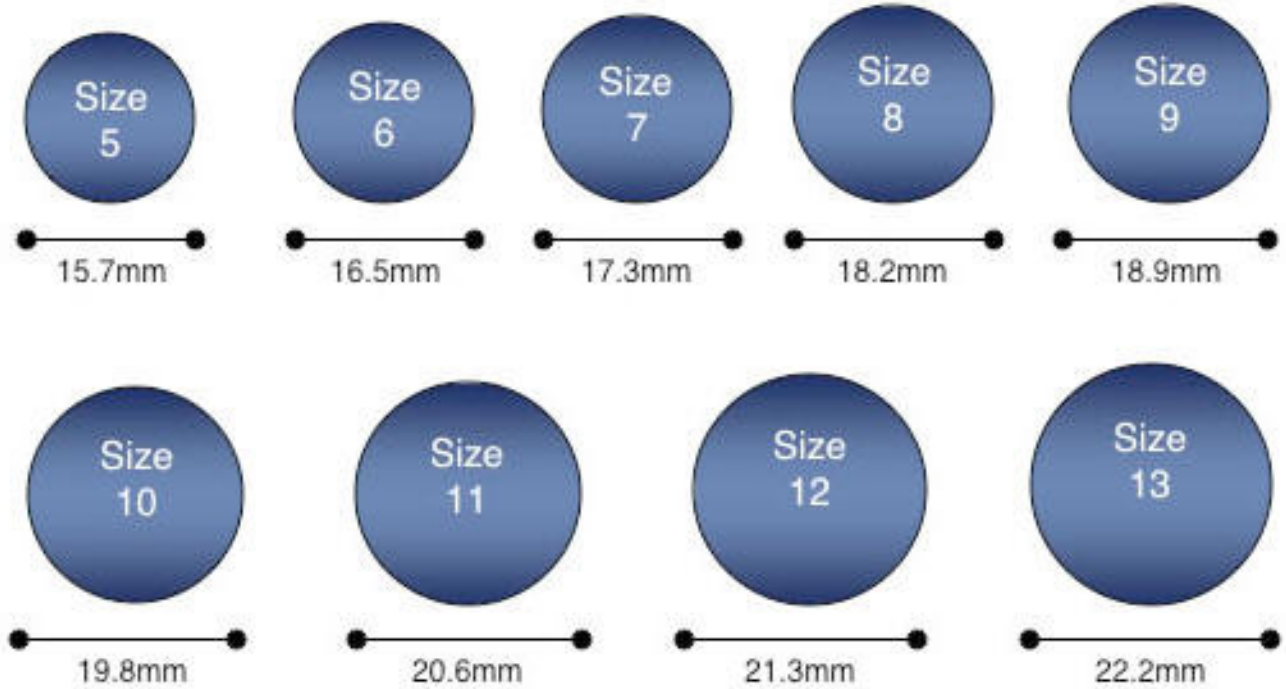


Measure the length of the strip/thread. This is the circumference of the ring. You may now refer to the chart below and determine your corresponding size.

OPTION B

Determine your ring size by using a ring that already fits you. Place this ring over the nearest size circle. The inner edge of the ring should align with the outer edge of the circle. If your ring seems to fit between two sizes, then opt for the larger size.



P.S. If nothing else works please got to a local jeweler and ask for a ring sizer to measure the size of your ring. Most jeweler would do it free of cost.
